Preschool Times

Morning Group: 8.15am to 11.15am

Our Program

The aim of the Preschool Program is to provide the opportunity for each child to learn actively in a stimulating environment. We endeavor to cater to individual child, building onto and developing the skills which each child brings with them.

Our Preschool Program is play based. Play provides opportunities for children to learn as they discover, create, improvise and imagine.

PMP- Perceptual Motor Program

3 days per week. Rotational activities which assist in development of Preschoolers motor skills.

EXCURSIONS: You will have signed a consent form for your child to go on excursions around town. This form is attached to our enrolment form.

BIRTHDAYS: These are very exciting times for young children and you are welcome to bring along a birthday cake to share with their classmates.

RECESS/ EATING TIME: Please supply your child with a "HEALTHY" snack. Remember it is not lunch. Please do not send soft drinks or lollies with your children.

TOYS: We do prefer that children do not bring their toys to Preschool. The Preschool staff take **NO** responsibility for any toys brought to the Preschool.

HOLIDAYS: If you are going away on holidays during the term please let the Preschool staff know in writing if possible.

LIBRARY

We have an extremely well stocked library with many books available for borrowing. Your child will need a cloth bag to carry their books. Bags are now available from the office. Children may borrow every day if they wish, or return them as time permits. If any books are lost or badly damaged parents may be asked to pay for a replacement book.

One of our aims is to develop in children a love of books, stories and poetry. Therefore, we encourage children to borrow books.

PRESCHOOL FUNDING
